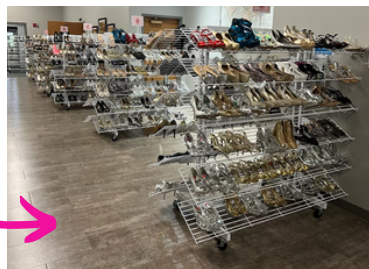

On March 14th, 15th and 16th Cinderella's Closet of NKY welcomed a record breaking **385 Princesses**. This was a **24% increase** from 2023! It took **237** volunteers to set up, take down and assist each princess with an experience she will never forget. Our set up crew this year consisted of Grant County High school, which was gracious enough to bring a bus to assist us Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday this year. The students and facility worked tirelessly to jump in wherever we needed assistance. We also welcomed back Fidelity Investments, their crew set up each of our dressing rooms this year and sorted our shoes and jewelry. We cannot forget the amazing muscle behind the magic, our "Godfathers"! Each year they work to ensure all the items are unloaded, set up and tore down with ease. We owe so much to these volunteers for helping us make the magic happen!

In addition to Shoe Racks, Cinderella's Closet opened for the first time ever on Thursday night to accommodate the growing number of Princesses. Transportation is often a concern and barrier for many girls, and by accommodating buses, we can ensure each Princess has the opportunity to have the dress of her dreams!
